



Assistant or Associate Professor Position in Quantitative Psychology

The Department of Psychology at Utah State University seeks candidates for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor position in its Quantitative Psychology specialization to begin August 2018. The successful candidate will have an active program of research in any area related to Quantitative Psychology. Possible research areas include, but are not limited to, measurement, psychometrics, multilevel analysis, structural equation modeling, longitudinal modeling, missing data analysis, Bayesian methods, causal inference, and intensive data analysis. We are particularly interested in individuals whose strengths complement those of existing faculty.

Utah State University is located in Logan within the beautiful mountain ranges of Northeastern Utah. The area provides a wealth of recreational possibilities, easy access to National Parks, a high quality of life, and an affordable cost of living.

Responsibilities Include:

- 1) Conducting research and other scholarly activities, including the pursuit of external funding.
- 2) Teaching undergraduate and graduate classes within area of expertise and department need. The typical departmental teaching load is four courses per year, but release from up to three courses per year is negotiable with external funding.
- 3) Mentoring graduate students on their research activities.
- 4) Providing service contributions to the university, college, and department, as well as in professional capacities nationally.

Minimum Qualifications (Assistant and Associate Professor Level):

- 1) Earned doctorate degree by August 2018 in Psychology or a closely related field.
- 2) Productivity in research and scholarly activities, and evidence of potential for grant funding. For appointment at the rank of Associate Professor, a sustained record of scholarly activities / peer-reviewed publications is required.
- 3) Evidence of excellent teaching potential and ability to mentor students. For appointment at the rank of Associate Professor, evidence of excellent teaching as well as effectiveness in mentoring students is required.
- 4) Excellent oral, written, and interpersonal skills.

Preferred Qualifications:

- 1) Current extramurally-funded research.
- 2) Previous university teaching and student mentoring experience.

Along with online application, please include:

- 1) Current curriculum vita.
- 2) Letter of intent that highlights fit to the minimum and preferred qualifications as well as information regarding short and long-term research goals.
- 3) A list of the names and contact information for at least three references familiar with your work.
- 4) Copies of recent course evaluations, if available.
