The DART Program's Summer Fellowship is a 10-week training program for promising medical, graduate and undergraduate students interested in research.



WHAT TO EXPECT

- Match with a basic science or clinical mentor who has a research focus in your area of interest
- Receive 1-on-1 mentorship and guidance on your own research project
- Experience working full-time in a research lab
- Collect data and run statistical analyses
- Attend weekly didactic seminars
- Write and submit a scientific abstract
- Attend DART Journal club
- Present a poster of your research at the annual Summer Research Day
- Receive a \$3,500 stipend to support your time and effort

HOW TO APPLY

Please visit our website, www.musc.edu/DART, and click on the Summer Fellowship page. You will need to complete the application and submit your **CV** and **Letter of Interest**.

Applications open on **November 1, 2018**. The deadline to apply is **February 1, 2019**.

Award notices will be sent via e-mail on **March 1, 2019**.

The Summer Fellowship begins **May 20, 2019**.
